2. Eligibility criteria/ qualifications for above mentioned posts are as follows:

(a) **PGT (Chemistry)** Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in Chemistry/ Bio-Chemistry and 50 percent in the aggregate.. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(b) **PGT (History)** Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in History and 50 percent in the aggregate. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(c) **PGT (Business Studies)** Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in Business Studies and 50 percent in the aggregate. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

- (d) **PGT (Physical Education)** A Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in Physical Education and 50 percent in the aggregate.
- (e) **Headmistress.** Masters or Graduate Degree, with a minimum aggregate of 50 percent, from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/AICTE in any one of the subjects taught in the Middle/ Primary classes of that Air Force School. Those holding a graduate degree in any other subject will not be eligible. However, if such candidate holds a Masters Degree in any of the subjects taught in the School, he/she will be eligible for the post. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/ National Council of Teachers Education. Teaching experience of at least two years as a PGT/ TGT/PRT or at least three years as a NTT or experience of at least two years as Principal/HM of an Air Force School.
- (f) **TGT (Social Studies).** A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in any two out of History, Geography, Economics or Political Science, of which one must be either History or Geography. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.
- (g) **TGT (Hindi).** A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in Hindi and 50 percent in the aggregate. Hindi as an elective subject at Degree level A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.
- (h) **TGT (Games)** A Masters Degree or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in Physical Education and 50 percent in the aggregate.
- (j) **Nursery Trained Teacher.** Senior Secondary with Nursery Teachers Training diploma or diploma in Nursery/Montessori/Pre-Primary Teachers Training from a Govt recognised institution.
- (k) **Special Educator.** Graduate with B.Ed (Special Educator) or B.Ed (General) with one year diploma in special education or B.Ed (General) with two years diploma in special education or B.Ed(General) with post graduate professional diploma in special education (PGPD) or B.Ed special education and post graduate professional certificate in special education (PGPC) or PG diploma in special education (mental retardation) or PG diploma in special education (locomotor impairment and cerebral palsy) or secondary level teacher training course in visual impairment or senior diploma in teaching the deaf or BA B.Ed in visual impairment.
- (l) **Computer Lab Attendant.** 10 + 2, Diploma in Computer Application and working knowledge in computer hardware and Networking.
- (m) **Junior Librarian.** Matriculation or equivalent with certificate in library science from a Government recognised institute.
- (n). **Helpers (Ayah/Watchman)** Should be able to understand Hindi and English.

(o) **Special Coaches (Basketball, Cricket, Taekwondo)** Sports Coach: NIS / Diploma in concerned game.

3. Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English [For Sl. no. (a) to (m) and (o)].
4. Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office [For Sl. no. (a) to (m)].
5. **Age.**

For Sl No 2 (e)

(aa) Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled. There will be no upper age limit in the case of serving staff of Air Force Schools but they should have at least two years of residual service as on 01 July of the academic year in which they are being considered for the post.

(ab) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(ac) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(ad) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/ TGT or three years as a PRT or NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

For Sl no 2 (a) to 2 (d) and 2 (f) to 2 (j)

(aa) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(ab) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(ac) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(ad) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School will be given age relaxation up to the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

For SI no 2 (k) to 2 (n)

(aa) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year.

(ab) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(ac) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(ad) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.
