1. Air Force School ASTE, (run by the Indian Air Force Educational and Cultural Society) invites applications for the following posts:

2. Eligibility criteria/ qualifications for above mentioned posts are as follows:

(a) **PGT (Informatics Practices)**. Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in Informatics Practices and 50 percent in the aggregate.

(b) **PGT (Chemistry)** Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in Chemistry/ Bio-Chemistry and 50 percent in the aggregate.. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(c) **PGT (History)** Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in History and 50 percent in the aggregate. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(d) **TGT (Science)**. Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a 50 percent in the aggregate including electives and languages and minimum marks of 50 percent in Botany, Zoology, Chemistry. Also candidates with Physics as one of the optional subjects can apply. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/ UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(e) **TGT (Hindi)**. A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in Hindi and 50 percent in the aggregate. Hindi as an elective subject at Degree level A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(f) **TGT (English)**. A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in English and 50 percent in the aggregate. English as an elective subject at Degree level A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(g) **TGT (Health Wellness)**. Graduate Degree, with a minimum aggregate of 50 percent, from any University recognised by the Govt of India/UGC/AICTE. Diploma in Counselling from a Teacher recognised University or BA/BSc Psychology with Educational Psychology/Counselling Psychology from a recognised University or MA/MSc in Counselling Psychology or MA/MSc Psychology with Counselling Psychology as specialisation or MA/ MSc in Applied Psychology with Counselling Psychology from a recognised University.

(h) **Primary Teachers**. A Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/UGC/AICTE, with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the aggregate. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(j) **Primary Teacher (Music)**. Degree in Music from a Govt recognised University OR Higher Secondary with any of the following, viz., Sangeet Visharad of GandharvaMahavidyalaya Mumbai OR Bhatkhande Sangeet Vidyapeeth, Lucknow OR Indira Kala Sangeet Vishwavidyalaya, Khairagarh (Chhattisgarh) OR Sangeet Prabhakar Examination of Prayag Sangeet Samiti, Allahabad OR Equivalent qualification from other Govt recognised institutions. OR Degree/Diploma awarded by Pracheen Kala Kendra, Chandigarh in the following categories, viz., Sangeet Bhaskar with graduation in any discipline, Sangeet/ Nritya Bhushan with graduation in any discipline, Sangeet Bhushan with Sr Sec/ Sec/ Pt I of three-year degree course and Sangeet/ Nritya Visharad with Sr Sec/ Sec/ Pt I of three-year degree course

(k) **Nursery Trained Teacher**. Senior Secondary with Nursery Teachers Training diploma or diploma in Nursery/Montessori/Pre-Primary Teachers Training from a Govt recognised institution.

(l) **Special Educator**. Graduate with B.Ed (Special Educator) or B.Ed (General) with one year diploma in special education or B.Ed (General) with two years diploma in special education or B.Ed(General) with post graduate professional diploma in special education (PGPD) or B.Ed special education and post graduate professional certificate in special education (PGPC) or PG diploma in special education (mental retardation) or PG diploma in special education (locomotor impairment and cerebral palsy) or secondary level teacher training course in visual impairment or senior diploma in teaching the deaf or BA B.Ed in visual impairment.

(m) **Computer Lab Attendant.** 10 + 2, Diploma in Computer Application and working knowledge in computer hardware and Networking.

(n) **Junior Librarian.** Matriculation or equivalent with certificate in library science from a Government recognised institute.

(o). **Helpers (Ayah/Watchman)** Should be able to understand Hindi and English.

(p) **Special Coaches (Cricket/Taekwondo/Basketball).** NIS/Diploma in concerned game.

3. Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English [For Sl. no. (a) to (n) and (p)].

4. Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office [For Sl. no. (a) to (n)].

5. **Age.**

For Sl no 2 (a) to (n)

(aa) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year.

(ab) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(ac) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(ad) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.

For Sl no 2 (o)

(aa) Should be in the age group of 21 to 40 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(ab) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(ac) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(ad) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years.
